



2nd Fragile X International Congress – Statement of Purpose

Oslo, Norway, November 5-6, 2026

The aim of this Congress is to bring together clinicians and researchers working in the area of FXS and FXPAC from across the globe, providing an international forum for the exchange of knowledge, ideas, and expertise. The Congress will give participants the opportunity to:

- Network and collaborate with international colleagues
- Be informed of the latest research, best practice, and experiences from across different regions and disciplines
- Actively workshop ideas through panel discussions
- Discuss translational research with a focus on clinical applications
- Explore disparities in diagnostic rates across countries, including challenges and opportunities in less-diagnosed regions
- Form relationships that support future international collaboration

All of this will take place within the context of Fragile X International's annual Members Conference, which will overlap with the Congress on Friday afternoon, allowing professionals and Member Delegates to discuss future research opportunities and learn from each other.

The audience for the first 1.5 days of the Congress will primarily be experts and colleagues, so talks will be high-level and scientific. Members will be invited to listen in, in order to remain informed of the latest developments in the field; however, presentations should be directed towards researchers and clinicians of various disciplines. Ample time will be allocated for discussion, with the aim of fostering open exchange and driving research forward through the meeting of minds.

The core speaker list comprises members of our Board of Advisors, and we are grateful for their time, leadership, and commitment. We have sought to ensure broad international representation, with experts from as many countries as possible and across the full range of topics related to FXS and FXPAC.
